

# NISL Financial Policies – Spring 2025

## Updated February 2025



To better serve our member clubs, ensure clear communication, and maintain professional youth soccer leagues, Northern IL Soccer League has established the **NISL Financial Policies**. This document outlines payment deadlines, expectations, and additional policies that clubs agree to as part of their membership agreement.

### **Payment Dates & Policy:**

All teams and clubs must pay their team's balance in full by **March 3rd** to ensure they are in good standing before their first game. **Teams with outstanding balances will not be permitted to compete in the 2025 NISL Spring season.**

NISL is committed to supporting its members, and our staff is available to discuss any concerns or specific circumstances with clubs as needed. Please don't hesitate to reach out.

See below for a breakdown for NPL and Club & Conference:

#### **NPL Payment Deadline (following \$800 deposit paid during registration)**

- One payment of \$2,200 (due March 3)
  - Note: NPL Player fees are due at the end of the month

#### **Club & Conference Payment Deadline**

- One payment for 100% of any remaining fall balance or spring fees (due March 3)
  - Note: Club & Conference Player fees are due at the end of the month

**Note: All credit card payments through GotSoccer are subject to a 3.5% transaction fee.**

### **Additional NISL Financial Policies:**

- Teams registering for NISL season after the registration deadline will incur an additional 10% fee
- Any team fees not paid by March 3 deadline, will incur an additional 10% fee – and may be sent to collections.
- All player fees are due by the end of the month of registration
- Clubs with unpaid balance from previous season will be prohibited from registering for, or competing in, future NISL seasons until the balance is paid in full.
- A club's balance includes any fines assessed
- If a club has recurring issues with payments, NISL may require a performance bond for future participation.
- Persistent non-payment may result in permanent removal from NISL
- NISL Fees are non-refundable
